(j) The parking of large vehicles and trailers. No person owning or having control of any truck, trailer, truck power unit, tractor, bus, RV, boat or any other large vehicle or trailer with an empty weight in excess of 11,000 pounds gross vehicle weight rating (gvwr) or 25 feet in length (including accessories, racks, or other physical extensions), shall park the same upon any street, avenue or public highway in the village for more than Twelve (12) consecutive hours with the exception of no parking on the 6 blocks of Main street for any length of time.

The provisions of this subsection shall not be deemed to prohibit the lawful parking of such equipment for actual maintenance or for the actual loading or unloading of goods, wares, or merchandise; provided, however, that the maintenance, loading and unloading shall be limited to the actual time consumed in such operation.

Exceptions:

- 1.) There shall be no parking for any length of time within 150 ft of the Norwalk Community Center or any church within the village limits.
- 2.) Construction equipment engaged in actual construction within village limits may obtain an exemption from the village board from these regulations.
- 3.) An overnight parking exemption may be obtained in advance from the Chief of Police if deemed necessary.

PENALTY

(b) Penalties shall be set forth in the Village of Norwalk Bond Schedule, referencing each code section.

Recommendation for bond schedule is as follows:

Year to start 11-1 to 10-31 \$25 for first offense, \$50 for second offense and \$100 each day thereafter
